Title / Position:	<p>Volunteer Tutor Assistant</p> <p>Classes for people with additional needs</p>
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Goal of position:	To assist the tutor in creating a safe environment for class members to experience and develop their own movement, express their own creativity, interact and work with others.
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Main duties and responsibilities:	
1	Help class members to get ready for the class and assist with register taking
2	Follow and provide example of the movement set by the tutor; prompting and encouraging individual class members and adapting movements to suit individuals where appropriate.
3	Provide 1-2-1 assistance as required by the tutor.
4	Follow and provide any appropriate assistance to class members regarding any tasks set by the tutor. Act as second adult/supporter identifying and referring any problems, difficulties or potential hazards as appropriate.
5	Work seamlessly with the tutor by anticipating their needs so that together you can provide a fun and supportive learning environment for younger dancers.
