What is the Boost Creative Careers Bursary Scheme?

Boost Bursaries are open to creatives aged over 18 who are at the beginning of their careers, with little to no previous professional experience in the arts. The scheme offers paid, hands-on placements in professional arts settings. Whether you're into producing, design, technical theatre, marketing, or community engagement, this is your chance to get stuck in, grow your skills, and build your future.

It could be that you've just finished college and want to make your first steps in the working world, or you're looking for a career change and on the lookout for experience in the arts.

Purpose of the Placement

Following the Covid lockdown, performing arts organisations across Suffolk have experienced some difficulty in finding lighting and sound technicians to cover the broad range of events that take place across our region. In addition, due to the scale and nature of many of Suffolk's arts organisations, the value of multi-disciplinary technicians has never been stronger.

As such, DanceEast are looking for technically minded candidates who are looking to broaden their skills portfolio and engage with the professional cultural sector in the disciplines of lighting, sound and video.

Who is the ideal candidate?

The Boost Bursary Scheme is for individuals with little to no previous professional experience in the arts. For this placement, the ideal candidate would be a technically minded individual who can demonstrate some engagement with:

- either lighting and/or sound in a school setting, who are looking to develop a career in live performance
- either lighting and/or sound in a community or amateur setting who are looking to develop a career in live performance
- related disciplines such as computer networking, coding, video editing and games design looking to develop a career in live performance.

Ways we can support you

- Facilitate key skills training to broaden your employability
- Give you access to the excellent technical facilities at DanceEast
- Linking to other cultural institutions to enable freelance opportunities
- Offer general insight on our process for working with freelance crew
- Offer CV and career advice/tips, and opportunities for networking

How the placement will work

You will be expected to work 60 hours per month over a period of three months. A schedule of work and a programme of training will be agreed with you prior to the start of the placement.

You will directly engage at a technical level across DanceEast's live performance and digital activity using your existing skills as well as your newly developing ones. This will include some evening work. Periods will be assigned where you will have dedicated access to equipment and infrastructure where you can practice and test your skills in a safe environment.

Fee

The total Boost Bursary offered is £2,500.

This will be paid in three instalments to be agreed at the beginning of your placement.
