What to expect when you visit the Jerwood DanceHouse  
for a performance





DanceEast is at the Jerwood DanceHouse in Ipswich. This is based on the corner of Foundry Lane and Saint Peters Dock along Ipswich Waterfront.



This is what the main entrance looks like from the outside.



There are two sets of sliding doors you walk through to enter.





Once you enter, you will be greeted by our friendly team at the box office. You can collect your tickets for the show, and they will be able to help with any questions you have.



On the right-hand side of the box office is our café where you can buy a pre-show drink and snack.



The lift can be found as you enter the building, turning left around the corner and past the window.



Our foyer space is on the left-hand side of the box office. When you have collected your tickets or if you already have them, you can head straight here before the show. There are comfy seats, tables and benches where you can sit and relax before, during and after the show.



There is a bar along the back wall of the foyer where you can buy a drink.



There is a watercooler to the left of the bar if you get thirsty.

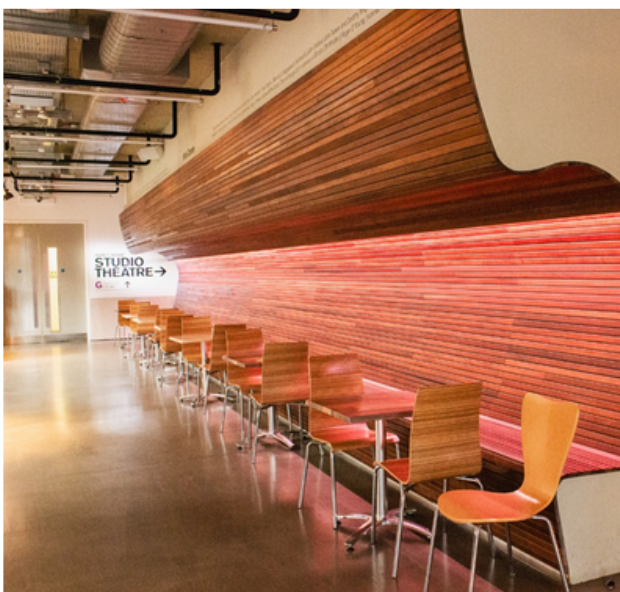




Toilets can be found to the left of the box office, straight through the glass door, past the staircase, and down the corridor. There are male, female, wheelchair access and baby changing toilet facilities.



By the staircase, there is a clothing rail for you to hang up and leave your coat before the performance. There is also space to leave buggies and wheelchairs.



You can also use our gender neutral and accessible toilets. Walk past the wooden benches and through the double doors next to the water cooler. Turn left through the second set of doors and then turn right.



These orange doors are the entrances to the theatre.



There are two entrances to the main theatre, each end of the wooden bench. Our friendly team of ushers will check your ticket and will be happy to help you to find the right entrance and locate your seat.



For some performances, you can also enter the theatre from the Whistler Gallery which is located on the first floor. These are wheelchair accessible and can be accessed by the lift.

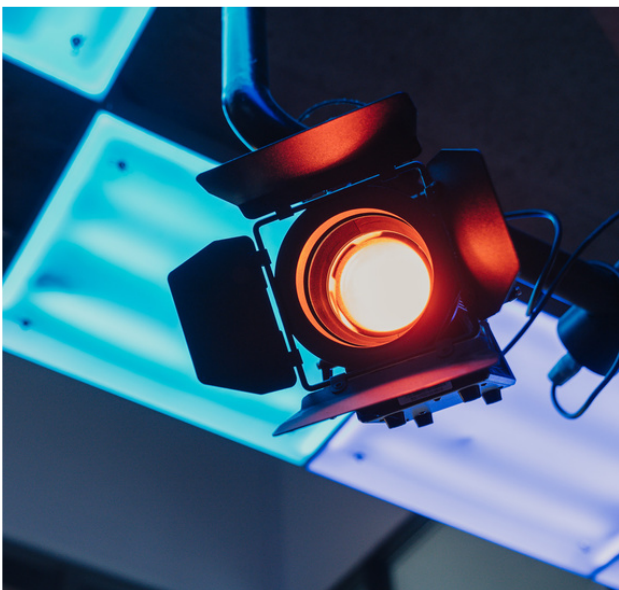




This is the auditorium where the show will take place. There are stairs to reach your seat. The lights will go off before the show starts.



The seating on the front row is wheelchair accessible. Speak to a member of our box office team for further information.



After the show finishes the lights in the auditorium come back on and everyone will leave. If you prefer, you are welcome to wait in your seat and leave when it becomes quieter.
